

HOW TO SET UP YOUR BC SERVICES CARD APP

Link Your BC Services Card to Access
Emergency E-Transfer Supports




To be eligible for Emergency Support Services (ESS)
e-transfer, you must link your BC Services Card
when registering.
Scan the QR code or visit:
www.gov.bc.ca/bcservicescard



Set Up the BC Services App

1. **Download** the **BC Services Card App** from your app store.
2. **Open the app** and follow the prompts:
 - Allow **notifications** (this helps you remember your paired device).
 - Read and accept the **Terms of Use**.
 - Review **privacy info** and **secure your phone** with a locking code.
 - i. Keep this code until your ERA file is complete.
3. You'll need a **valid BC Care Card** (or Enhanced Driver's License) to proceed.



Step 1: Provide Valid ID

Choose one of the following:


1. Indigenous Status Card
2. Passport
3. BC Driver's License / Enhanced License
4. Military or Government-issued ID
5. Health Card
6. Canadian Citizenship Card (issued before Feb 1, 2012)
7. Permanent Resident Card (Canada or U.S.)



Step 2: Provide Your Email Address

You'll receive a confirmation code to:

- Verify access to the email
- Confirm it was entered correctly




Step 3: Verify Your Identity

Complete a one-time identity check:

- By Video
- In Person at a Service BC location

Tip: Do this early — it can take time to process.



Final Step: Create Your ERA Profile

Once your identity is verified, use the app to create your **Emergency Registration & Assistance (ERA)** profile.

In Case of Evacuation

Go to your local **Reception Centre** and let the ESS responder know: "I've pre-registered with ESS through the BC Services Card app."
