

## BYLAW NO. 1488, 2020

A bylaw to defer the 2020 Annual Tax Sale

WHEREAS under the *Local Government Act* S.645 authorizes Council to conduct an annual tax sale on the last Monday of September;

AND WHEREAS, a declaration of a state of emergency throughout the whole of the Province of British Columbia was declared on March 18, 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic;

AND WHEREAS under Ministerial Order No. M159 under the *Emergency Program Act* Section 15 (1) allows Council to defer the annual tax sale for 2020, provided for under Division 7 [*Annual Municipal Tax Sale*] of Part 16 [*Municipal Provisions*] of the *Local Government Act*, until September 27, 2021, with the effect that the annual tax sale would be on that date in respect of the upset price described in section 649 [*upset price for tax sale*] of that Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Hope, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

## 1. CITATION

This bylaw may be cited as the *District of Hope 2020 Annual Tax Sale Deferment Bylaw No. 1488, 2020.* 

## 2. ENACTMENT

That the 2020 annual tax sale be deferred until September 27, 2021.

Read for a first, second and third time this 27<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2020.
