Westcoast Interconnection Project

Notice of Survey Work

August 18 to 29, 2025

Beginning the week of August 18, survey crews will be working along the proposed route for the Westcoast Interconnection Project. The data gathered will help the project team confirm the feasibility of this route (see map below).

The survey crews will use drones to capture the existing ground surface, structures, and power line components along the route and intend to fly the drone at an altitude no higher than 120 meters. We'll also have crews on the ground to confirm legal boundaries of the various land classifications and existing third-party infrastructure along the route. Crews and drones will remain within the road allowance and will not enter private properties.
