Completing only the Candidate Cover Sheet and Checklist Form C1 **does not** constitute completion of the Candidate Nomination Package, nor does it satisfy the legislative requirements set out in the Local Government Act, Local Elections Campaign Financing Act,

Financial Disclosure Act and/or Vancouver Charter.

- 2. Record the office for which the Candidate is seeking election.

## Who has access to the information on this form?

Under section 6 (1) of the Act, statements of disclosure filed by nominees or municipal officials are available for public inspection during normal business hours. Statements filed by designated employees are not routinely available for public inspection. # 1) TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PLACEMENT OF ELECTION SIGNAGE:

"Election signage" includes any and all promotional materials advertising a candidate or a political party in a federal, provincial, or local government election or position on an issue in an assent vote.

# 2) TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PLACEMENT OF ELECTION SIGNAGE:

- Dates by when signage may be placed and by when it must be removed;
- Locations in which signage may be placed (i.e. private property or public property)
- Location in which signage may not be placed (i.e. public property)
- Sizes of the signage
- Limits as to the number of signage that may be placed at the same location.
- Elections signage shall **not**:
  - be unsightly, dilapidated, structurally unsafe, illuminated, a traffic distraction
     or interfere with the safety of vehicles, cyclists or pedestrians;
  - o be permitted to be attached or affixed to parked vehicles or trailers;
  - visually obstruct, simulate, or detract from any traffic control signs;
  - be attached to utility poles, fences, trees or any other similar structure where they are visible from a public road or public place;
  - o be located within 100 metres of a voting place on voting days.

 Election signage may be removed for cause if considered by the CEO as not meeting the requirements of this acknowledgment or the District of Hope Sign Bylaw No. 35/96.

# Excerpt from District of Hope Sign Bylaw No. 35/96

#### 6.13 POLITICAL SIGNS

#### Permitted Zones

 Political signs shall be permitted in all zones in the District of Hope Zoning Bylaw.

#### Sign Area

The sign area of a political sign shall not exceed 1.5 square meters in total.

#### Number of Signs

3. There shall be no more than 1 political sign on any private lot.


#### Height

Political signs shall not exceed a height of 2.5 meters above grade.

#### Special Conditions

- No political sign shall be erected more than 30 days before an election or referendum and must be removed within 7 days after the election or referendum.
- Political signs shall not be placed on either private or public property without the approval of the owner.
