<p>(a) In addition to the impound fees imposed pursuant to this Bylaw, the owner, harbourer or possessor of a vicious dog will also be liable for all extraordinary costs incurred by the Animal Control/Bylaw Enforcement Officer in the course of impounding the dog and these costs will be payable at the time of reclamation.</p> <p>(b) If a vicious dog is unlicensed at the time of impoundment then the licence fee for the current year will be \$200.00 in addition to the impound fee, and a licence subsequently issued.</p> <p>(c) The owner of an impounded vicious dog must provide the Animal Control/Bylaw Enforcement Officer with proof of valid liability insurance covering the actions of the dog for the current year prior to the issuance of a licence or the dog being reclaimed.</p> <p>(d) The Schedule of Impound Fees for vicious dogs will be cumulative over time and will not follow the calendar year.</p> <p>(e) Any fines, impound fees, and any other costs imposed by this bylaw are payable by the owner of the dog, regardless of whether the dog is reclaimed by the owner.</p>
